



Transportation Options from Phoenix Sky Harbor Airport

- Taxis
 - Taxis are readily available upon arrival. Taxis can be at Terminal 2 at east outside door #8, in Terminal 3 at the north curb, outside door #7 and in Terminal 4 on Level 1 at the north curb, outside door #7 and south curb, outside door #6.
 - Taxis cannot be scheduled in advance. The following taxi companies are contracted to pick up passengers at Phoenix Sky Harbor: AAA/ Yellow Cab, Mayflower Cab, and VIP Taxi.
 - Rates remain the same regardless of company, number of passengers, and number of bags.
 - The first mile is \$5. Each additional mile is \$2.30. Each hour of a traffic delay is \$23. The minimum fare is \$15.
- Shared Ride
 - Ride share services are available 24 hours a day, seven days a week.
 - Terminal pick-up locations for ride share service providers are as follows: Terminal 2: East outside door #8, Terminal 3: South curb, west end outside door #4, Terminal 4: Level 1, north curb, far west end outside door #1, and Terminal 4: Level 1, south curb, far east end, outside door #8.
 - ***Please note, both Uber and Lyft are in negotiations with the City of Phoenix and this service may be suspended.***
- Private car services
 - You can arrange a private car of your choice. Use your search engine to discover available companies in the area.
- Public Transportation
 - The free PHX Sky Train® runs regularly from Sky Harbor to the connection station to transfer to downtown Phoenix and is only minutes away from Sky Harbor terminals.
 - Passengers can take the PHX Sky Train from Terminal 3 or 4 to the 44th street PHX Sky Train. From there, follow the walkway with moving sidewalks on level 2 to the elevator and escalator down to the Valley Metro Rail platform at 44th Street and Washington, at the 44th St/Washington Valley Metro Rail station, board a westbound train into downtown Phoenix. The Washington/3rd street stop is adjacent to the Phoenix Convention Center and within walking distance to convention hotels.
 - Valley Metro Rail tickets cost for \$2 for a one-way trip or an all-day pass for \$4 (the pass is also valid for buses).
 - The PHX Sky Train is designed for travelers with luggage and runs seven days a week, 24 hours a day. See diagram [here](#).

 - Street Parking available. All meters and pay stations are enforced 8 a.m. to 10 p.m. daily, including weekends and holidays. Credit card meters cost \$1.50 per hour and coin-only meters cost \$1 per hour.
